**Coaches Lunch:** Coach's lunch will be provided. You will be given details at check in.

First team to referee, please arrive at 7:40 AM and make sure that the net is at the correct height, and all supplies at the scorer's table.

**Coaches:** Please Stop at Tournament Desk (on the lower level) and check in. Make sure that your roster is correct and complete. All Players listed on the tournament entry form MUST be registered with HOA. Please help us stay on schedule.

**Coaches meeting at 7:40 AM.**

**Parent Representative Meeting at 7:50 AM.**

After 3<sup>rd</sup> match, all matches should start 2 minutes after previous match.

**Warm-ups:** When teams are playing their first match of the day: 2 minutes ball handling, each team on their side of the net. After that, there will be 4 minutes court time for the Serving team, followed by 4 minutes court time for the receiving team.

In single day tournaments, no tie-breaking sets will be played if ties can be broken on sets or points. The only situation which requires playing a tie-breaking set, is if all other tie-breaking options are depleted, and the only remaining option is a coin toss. This is mandatory for all tournaments.

**Tie breaker match, only if a team is eliminated from advancing to playoffs. Otherwise, use a coin flip. If required, a tie-breaker set will have the same length as pool play matches (either 25 or 21 points).**

**Playoffs:** Playoff rules will be posted the day of the tournament. At least 2 teams from each pool will advance to playoffs. Playoffs will be two out of three games, first 2 - 25 points, starting at 4-4 (no cap). Third set if necessary will be 15-point rally scoring with NO cap, starting 0-0. If a 1 set playoff is necessary, it will be one set to 25 starting at 4-4.

During Playoffs the losing team is required to officiate the following match. Tournament Director may allow a losing team to be released under certain circumstances.

**Camp Area:** Keep camp area clean and neat. Space is limited so please do not spread out. If told by tournament officials to limit your camp area or clean your area, please respect their directions.

Jerseys of the same color, type and style, and shorts similar in color are required for all Sanctioned tournaments. Uniforms must be numbered in accordance with current USAV rules. If garments are worn under the jersey and exposed, they will be considered part of the uniform and must be similar and of the same color. Shorts can be any style but of a similar color. Failure to comply with these requirements for any reason, accidental or intentional, will result in the following penalties being assessed against the club/team in violation: 3 points for shirt and 3 points for shorts each set. A maximum of a 5-point penalty (no matter how many players have different shorts and shirts) being assessed. The officiating team shall be charged with applying this rule automatically and any appeal will be made to the tournament director.

Premier level teams must play always with 6 players. Select teams can start with 5 players, except when playing in Premier level tournaments.

In the age groups up to 14 and under, the Head or Assistant Coach must be the "up"-official. In the age groups 15 and older a rostered coach is either the R1, R2 or Scorer. Coaches who are not present or walk away during an officiating assignment will be penalized with a 5 points penalty PER SET in their next match.

- 5 Team Pool Play: Two 21 point sets. Beginning at 4-4, no cap.
- 6 Team Pool Play: Two 21 point sets. Beginning at 4-4, no cap.
- 7 Team Pool Play: Two 21 point sets. Beginning at 4-4, no cap.

Playoffs will be two out of three sets, first 2 - 21 point (no cap). Third set, if necessary will be a 15 point with NO cap. During Playoffs the losing team is required to officiate the following match.
