House Rules at Blue Valley Recreation Center at Hilltop: No Coolers/outside food/crockpots allowed inside building. Water bottles and single-serve drinks may be brought into the facility if they have a lid. No outside chairs. Bleachers are available for spectators. Chair backs for the bleachers are allowed. Concessions will be open.

Camp Areas: Room 108, 110, and 111. There is also space behind the bleachers on the courts. DO NOT camp in hallways, in front of doors, or in the front lobby. Please, keep your camp area neat and clean-up at the end of the day.

Coaches: Stop at Tournament Desk and check in. Make sure that your roster is correct and complete.

Coaches Credentials: Each coach that wants to be on the bench must have their credentials. If you cannot show them, you will have to show your membership card, proof of IMPACT and SafeSport certification, and a picture ID. If you cannot show proof of Impact/SafeSport certification and/or membership you can NOT coach! The only adults that can be on a team bench are the ones that wear the green credentials. The only adults that are to help out at the scorer's table do lines or help with shagging balls either have to wear the red Parent member credential or the green coach's credential. All coaches are to wear the credentials around their neck, clearly visible, at all times.

First team to referee: Please arrive at 7:40 AM and make sure that the net is at the correct height, and all supplies are at the scorer's table. Call for Captains at 7:45 and then start warm-ups. Play starts promptly at 8:00 AM.

Coaches Meeting: 7:40 AM (Please attend!). Coaches, please have your HOA-issued coaching credentials and proper ID (Drivers License) with you when you check your team in.

Parent Representative Meeting: 7:50 AM

Coaches: Please stop at tournament desk to check-in when you arrive. Make sure your roster is correct and complete. All players listed on the tournament entry form MUST be registered with HOA. Please help us stay on schedule.

Officiating Duties: For 15s and above, a coach must be R1, R2, or the active scorekeeper. For 14s and under, the coach must be the R1. We also emphasize having a registered parent rep or assistant sit at the score table to help with scorekeeping.

Warm-ups: Warm-Ups start immediately after the end of the previous match. 2 minutes ball handling, each team on their side of the net. After that, there will be 4 minutes court time for the Serving team, followed by 4 minutes court time for the Receiving team.

- 4 Team Pool Play where not all teams advance to playoffs: Three 21 point sets. Beginning at 4-4, no cap.
- 5 Team Pool Play: Two 21 point sets. Beginning at 4-4, no cap.
- 6 Team Pool Play: Two 21 point sets. Beginning at 4-4, no cap.
- 7 Team Pool Play: Two 21 point sets. Beginning at 4-4, no cap.

Playoffs will be two out of three sets, first 2 - 21 point (no cap). Third set, if necessary will be a 15 point with NO cap.
