House Rules at The New Century Fieldhouse: No Coolers inside building. Water bottles for players are allowed.

First team to referee, please arrive at 7:30 AM and make sure that the net is at the correct height, and all supplies at the scorer's table.

Coaches: Please Stop at Tournament Desk and check in. Make sure that your roster is correct and complete. All Players listed on the tournament entry form MUST be registered with HOA. Please have a coach/parent courtside during referee duties.

Coaches meeting at 7:40 AM by the tournament desk

Parent Representative Meeting at 7:50 AM.

After 3rd match, all matches should start 2 minutes after previous match.

Warm-ups: When teams are playing their first match of the day: 2 minutes ball handling, each team on their side of the net. After that, there will be 4 minutes court time for the Serving team, followed by 4 minutes court time for the receiving team.

Coaches Credentials: Each coach that wants to be on the bench must have their credentials. If you cannot show them, you will have to show your membership card, proof of IMPACT certification and a picture ID. If you cannot show proof of impact certification and/or membership you can NOT coach! The only adults that can be on a team bench are the ones that wear the green credentials. The only adults that are to help at the scorer's table do lines or help with shagging balls either must wear the red Parent member credential or the green coach's credential. All coaches are to wear the credentials around their neck, clearly visible, always.

No Outside food/crock pots/coolers- Our concession has been redesigned to accommodate the need for healthier menu items. We have items such as turkey sandwiches and chicken wraps, fruit and baked chips. All reasonably priced. For your convenience team order forms are also available.

Please visit the concession stand for details. Please honor the food rules to help keep rental fees down. You can enter and leave the facility at your leisure, so it's fine to store/eat outside food in your vehicle.

We do allow single serving drinks brought into the facility with a lid or cap. No oversized liquid containers meant for more than one person.

No bag chairs at New Century- To keep our sports surfaces in the best shape possible, we do not allow bag chairs (aka camping chairs) inside of our facility. Chair backs for bleachers are allowed. Please choose one of the seating options available inside the facility.

New Century: If you would like to rent a room for your team, the cost is \$150 per day. All normal facility rules still apply, but you can have a dedicated space for your use. Please call (913) 826-2850 to book or for more information. Thank you and we look forward to your visit.

Playoffs: At least 2 teams from each pool will advance to playoffs. Playoffs will be two out of three games, first 2 - 25 points, starting at 4-4 (no cap). Third game if necessary will be 15-point rally scoring with NO cap, starting 0-0. If a 1 game playoff is necessary, it will be one game to 15 starting at 0-0.

During Playoffs the losing team is required to officiate the following match. Tournament Director may allow a losing team to be released under certain circumstances.

Camp Area: Keep camp area clean and neat, do not spread out. If told by tournament officials to clean your area, please respect their directions.

Jerseys of the same color, type and style, and shorts similar in color are required for all Sanctioned tournaments. Uniforms must be numbered in accordance with current USAV rules. If garments are worn under the jersey and exposed, they will be considered part of the uniform and must be similar and of the same color. Shorts can be any style but of a similar color. Failure to comply with these requirements for any reason, accidental or intentional, will result in the following penalties being assessed against the club/team in violation: 3 points for shirt and 3 points for shorts each set. A maximum of a 5-point penalty (no matter how many players have different shorts and shirts) being assessed. The officiating team shall be charged with applying this rule automatically and any appeal will be made to the tournament director.

Gold level teams must play always with 6 players. Silver and Bronze teams can start with 5 players, except when playing in Gold level tournaments.

In the age groups up to 14 and under, the Head or Assistant Coach must be the "up"-official. In all other age groups, a coach must be in a key role during their teams officiating duties. That means that there is an adult Head or Assistant Coach either acting as up ref or down ref. Coaches who are not present or walk away during an officiating assignment will be penalized with a 5 points penalty PER SET in their next match.

In the age groups 15 and up, a coach needs to be in the R1, or the R2 position or scorer.

- 4 Team Pool Play where all teams advance to playoffs: Two 21 point sets. Beginning at 4-4, no cap.
- 4 Team Pool Play where not all teams advance to playoffs: Three 21 point sets. Beginning at 4-4, no cap.
- 5 Team Pool Play: Two 21 point sets. Beginning at 4-4, no cap.
- 6 Team Pool Play: Two 21 point sets. Beginning at 4-4, no cap.
- 7 Team Pool Play: Two 21 point sets. Beginning at 4-4, no cap.

Playoffs will be two out of three sets, first 2 - 21 point (no cap). Third set, if necessary will be a 15 point with NO cap. During Playoffs the losing team is required to officiate the following match.
